STEM (SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING & MATHS) EVENT AT NISSAN, CRANFIELD, JANUARY 2024

Around 160 students from nine local secondary schools attended a fantastic STEM event at the Nissan Technical Centre Europe in Cranfield, Milton Keynes.

After an introduction and welcome from the Regional Vice President of Nissan, the students were split into coloured teams. Each team had the opportunity to do eight separate activities linked to Nissan car design that were hands-on and fun. These included chocolate welding, egg crash testing, and gear systems, to name a few.

WORK EXPERIENCE 2024

By the time you read this newsletter, Proactive will already have organised and supported students from 4 schools on work experience in 2024, with a further 18 schools to follow between March and July.

Five of our work experience schools also offer their students extended placements.

EXTENDED PLACEMENTS

These are work experience placements where the student will do 1 or 2 days a week every week for a part or full academic year. This placement is reviewed half termly to make sure all is well with both placement provider & student.

Extended placements allow the student to have a gradual introduction to work experience but gain important knowledge, training and skills across the year.
